Installing and registering the **FREE** RoomView software enables enterprise-wide monitoring of up to 250 projectors, direct unit control, and status notifications such as lamp life, power state, and unit presence.

Using the onboard, Flash-based interface, Crestron + DLP also enables direct control of the projector from an in-room computer, and provides a connection to support services for technical assistance from any MAC, PC or mobile device.

Crestron + DLP includes emergency broadcast announcements via a projector's Closed Captioning system, helping to keep everyone instantly informed during critical events.

Connecting legacy and other installed projectors to the network can be accomplished by adding a low cost Crestron controller such as the compact QM-RMC. Now every AV device, in every room of the building or across a campus, can be managed and controlled by RoomView.

Crestron provides a straightforward upgrade path to RoomView Server Edition, a Web based, cross-platform solution for room monitoring, scheduling, Web cameras, and customizable attributes such as contacts, logs, reports and plug-in modules for calendars, hot lists and instant messaging.
